What Type of Testing Is Included?

Heart disease is the # 1 killer in the nation, followed by cancer, stroke and Diabetes.

The panel of tests will screen for the following:

- **Comprehensive Metabolic Panel (CMP)**

This panel gives your doctor important information about the current status of your kidneys, liver and electrolyte and acid/balance as well as of your blood sugar and blood proteins.

- **Lipid Profile**

Measures cholesterol, triglycerides, HDL and LDL

- **Complete Blood Count (CBC)**

Screening test to check anemia, infection and many other diseases.

- **Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH)**

Evaluates thyroid function and/or symptoms of hyperthyroidism or hypothyroidism.

- **Uric Acid** Detects Gout

- **Prostate Cancer Screening** (men only)

How Much Does It Cost?

This screening is available for only **\$40** through the program.

For an additional **\$18**, men can be screened for PSA.

Visa, Mastercard, cash and checks are forms of acceptable payment.

Participants may register in person at the Clay County Chamber of Commerce, located at 1734 Kingsley Avenue in Orange Park, between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Where Do I Go For Testing?

All blood testing is performed at participating laboratories which are listed on the back of this brochure. The results of the screening are strictly confidential. Results will be mailed directly to participants who are encouraged to share the results with their personal physicians.

You must bring the Test Request Form with you to the patient service center.
