## What Type of Testing is Included?

Heart disease is the # 1 killer in the nation, followed by cancer, stroke and Diabetes. Preventative screening saves lives. They can ensure that common, serious diseases and conditions are detected and treated.

The panel of tests will screen for the following:

- **Comprehensive Metabolic Panel (CMP)**

This panel gives your doctor important information about the current status of your kidneys, liver and electrolyte and acid/balance as well as of your blood sugar and blood proteins.

- **Lipid Profile**

Measures cholesterol, triglycerides, HDL and LDL

- **Complete Blood Count (CBC)**

Screening test to check anemia, infection and many other diseases.

- **Thyroid Stimulating Hormone (TSH)**

Evaluates thyroid function and/or symptoms of hyperthyroidism or hypothyroidism.

- **Uric Acid**

Detects Gout

- **Prostate Cancer Screening (men only)**
